Mason is a member of the Corporate Development team at Capital One. The team is responsible for acquisitions, divestitures, partnerships, and strategic growth initiatives across all of Capital One's business lines. His team partners with senior leadership to formulate acquisition strategy, manage external industry and investment bank relationships, and execute growth opportunities either through acquisition or partnership. Representative transactions include the acquisition of Bluetarp (Business Payments), Wikibuy (E-Commerce), Paribus (E-Commerce), and the acquisition of GE Healthcare Finance (Lending). He also led Capital One's exit from home lending through a sale of a \$18 billion mortgage portfolio to Credit Suisse and subsequent wind down of its business operations.

Mason joined Capital One in 2012 from Fidelity National Financial (NYSE: FNF) where he held the title of Vice President, Corporate Development. In this role, Mason was on a shared executive management team with FNF and Fidelity National Information Services ("FIS") responsible for acquisitions, divestitures, private equity, and distressed debt investments (for control) across its operating and portfolio companies.

Before joining Fidelity, he held roles at Deloitte and The Carlyle Group between 2005 and 2007. Mason graduated with a Masters in Accounting and Information Systems and a Bachelor's degree in Accounting, both from Virginia Tech, in 2005. He is a licensed CPA, though inactive.
