NO POLITICAL AFFILIATION

- Being that MDC is a non-partisan agency of Fairfax County, you may not promote yourself as affiliated with any political organization

NO VOTER MANIPULATION

- Bribery towards any other candidate, individual, voter, staff, board member, to perform or not perform any sort of action is strictly prohibited
- You may not hand out gifts, money, presents, treats, or goodie bags to any voter in return for their vote
- Black mailing is not allowed



REAL VOTES ONLY ADULT VOTERS: AGE 18 OR OLDER ON MCLEAN DAY (born on-or-before MAY 21, 2004)

- Do not fake ballots by completing them for your friends, neighbors, or any other individual.
- An adult voter must request and complete a ballot themselves with their own intentions.
- Requesting or having youth fill out adult ballots is strictly prohibited.

START CAMPAIGNING ON MARCH 12!

- Campaigning may commence after March 12 at 5:00 p.m. once you have been notified as a "certified candidate" and attended the candidate orientation session. You may continue campaigning until the end of the election on May 21, 2022 at 5:00 p.m.
- You may campaign at any public community gathering where allowed, with the exception of inside MDC facilities or events.
