CAMP McLEAN REFUND POLICY

- Requests made **BEFORE the first Friday in April** and submitted in writing to refunds@mcleancenter.org: Patron will receive a full refund.
- Requests made **AFTER the first Friday in April but MORE THAN 21 days ahead of the camp start date**: Patron will receive a full refund less a 20% administrative fee.
- Requests made **LESS THAN 21 days before the start of the camp**: Refunds will only be granted if the vacant spot is filled. Patron will receive a full refund less a 20% administrative fee.

How to Register

Registration begins on Monday, Feb. 2, 2026. Spaces fill quickly, so register as soon as possible to ensure your space. Be the first in line, register online! Online registration starts Monday, Feb. 2, at 9 a.m. Go to mcleancenter.org and click on the pink "Register" button under the seven-digit activity code associated with the activity you seek. You can also register over the phone or in person.

Camp Forms Camp Forms **MUST** be submitted one month prior to the start of camp. This gives parents/guardians time to complete any missing or otherwise incomplete forms prior to camp.

Note: All forms must be complete and on hand at camp before your child is admitted to camp. No exceptions will be made.

Required Camper Documents Include:

Forms will be available on the Camp McLean webpage. Camper Information Packet, a current and completed Certification of Immunization, a Commonwealth of Virginia School Entrance Physical Examination Form signed by a physician, a copy of form is acceptable. Any camper under the age of six years old must submit a Physical Examination form that is dated after August 1, 2025.

Virginia law, camp management is required to witness a document with proof of your child's age. You must bring one of the following items in when you submit paperwork for your child for camp. Note: Camp McLean staff will make a copy of the original document and return it to you. Please do not bring copies, as they are not acceptable, and make sure to take your original documents with you when you leave.

1. A certified copy of his or her birth certificate
2. U.S. Passport (or State Department-Issued documentation)
3. Virginia school report card






